AIR DEFENCE IDENTIFICATION ZONE

EXERCISE WINTER SOLSTICE FAMM, FAKM AND FABL

Validity Period: 26 July 2012 to 4 August 2012

1. The SA Air Force (SAAF) will conduct an airspace security exercise in order to exercise forces and doctrine regarding airspace security and border patrolling. To ensure that all simulations are carried out in a safe and secure environment, the SAAF is declaring an Air Defense Identification Zone (ADIZ) within which specific procedures will apply.

1.1 Air Defence Identification Zone North West

- (a) A temporary Air Defense Identification Zone, extending from GND to FL195 and excluding all promulgated controlled airspace, is declared along the following points:

From a point S242041.4 E0264214.2 (Louisiana airstrip) a straight line to a point at S255139.81 E0265335.38 (Koster town), then a straight line to a point at S265936.31 E0264005.32 (Orkney town). Thence along the Vaal river to a point at S290258.07 E0234606.16 (Douglas town), then north up to the Mahohomal airstrip (S263055.85 E0220942). From Mahohomal follow the RSA/Botswana border northeast back to Louisiana airstrip (S242041.4 E0264214.2).

- (b) For identification and flight safety purposes all flights entering the ADIZ must submit an ATS flight plan. In addition, all VFR flights entering or operating inside the ADIZ must obtain flight authorization from the SAAF at least 24 hours prior to the flight. VFR Authorization numbers are to be included into field 18 of the ATS flight plan, e.g. RMK/Auth Nr _____.
- (c) Flight authorization can be obtained from the SAAF on the following numbers:

- (d) In order to activate the flight plan, all VFR flights inside the ADIZ must contact the SAAF Flight Monitoring Services on TIBA (124,8 MHz), call-sign "SAAF Info". SAAF controllers will provide limited flight information and monitoring service on TIBA for safety and security purposes.
- (e) The ADIZ and its associated rules will be enforced from 25 July 2012, 2201 (effectively 0001 on 26 July 2012) until 4 August 2012, 2200.

2. Warning

Any aircraft observed flying without a flight plan or deviating from the filed flight plan, or negotiated route, may be subject to interception as per ICAO publication and may be subject to prosecution.

Increased military flight activities will take place in this airspace and pilots are to exercise caution and adhere to all published procedures.
